How Do I Qualify?

- If a teacher holds a current or expired <u>Initial</u> or <u>Continuing</u> NC Educator's License, they may qualify to be a Meck Pre-K Lead Teacher.
- If the teacher does not hold a NC Educator's License, they are required to have a relevant or related BA/BS degree from a regionally accredited college or university with a minimum GPA of 2.5.

- If the BA/BS degree is not in a related or relevant field, the teacher is required to have a minimum of 24 semester hours of early childhood education/child development coursework. These semester hours can only be counted by EESLPD Unit staff.

Required Documentation for Enrollment

Teachers who require a NC Lateral Entry Birth-Kindergarten License must submit the following:

- All official degreed and nondegreed transcripts
- Official Plan of Study
- Form V Verification of Completion of Education (if applicable)
- Form E Verification of K-12 Educator Experience (optional)

Teachers who hold a NC Educator's License must submit the following:

- Legible copy of teaching license
- Official Plan of Study for Pre-K/BK Add On (if applicable)
- Form E Verification of K-12 Educator Experience (optional)

Teachers who hold an Out of State License must submit the following:

- All official degreed and nondegreed transcripts
- Legible copy of teaching license
- Test Scores
- Form V Verification of Completion of Education (if applicable)
- Form E Verification of K-12 Educator Experience (optional)

*Please note that each teacher's educational background differs and additional documentation may be requested.

Plan of Study: College/University

A Plan of Study from a NC College/University is required for teachers seeking the following licenses:

- Lateral Entry BK License
- Provisional BK Add-on
- Provisional Pre-K Add-on
