

COVID-19 Safety Measures



- Centers will provide instructions to families with specific instructions tailored to their locations, if any.
- Adults and children age 2 and over should wear face masks in classrooms.
- “Wear-Wait-Wash” posters at entrance and in classrooms to promote face coverings, social distancing and hand washing.
- Hand washing with soap, frequent use of hand sanitizer and tissues, and frequent hygiene breaks.
- Isolation of anyone who shows COVID-19 symptoms, followed by sending them home safely as soon as possible.
- Mandatory isolation or quarantine of children or staff who have tested positive for COVID-19, have COVID-19 symptoms, or have been in close contact with someone who has COVID-19 or COVID-19 symptoms.
- Face coverings for all staff, and for children, over the age of 2 when possible.
- Regular cleaning and disinfecting of frequently touched objects and surfaces (such as toys, cubbies, doorknobs, counter tops, etc.).
- Prioritizing outdoor time when possible.
