Key Services

Referrals: The team receives referrals from teachers when a student, family, or educational team needs specialized assistance. They then provide additional support based on the needs.

Assessments: The team conducts additional assessments to measure a student's abilities at their current stage of development.

Intake Process: The team gathers basic information on a student or family so that a tailored support plan can be created.

IEP Evaluation: IEP Evaluation is a formal process used to determine whether a child is eligible for individual education services and what those services should include.

Individualized Education Plans: Evaluations are completed by Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools, but our Child Development Team can support families by participating in meetings and helping to understand the document.

Ongoing Support: Family Engagement Specialists provide workshops, family-centered activities, and personalized assistance for families facing challenges.
